Eligible Institutions	Only IRCCS (The Italian Scientific Institutes for Health Research and Health Care). Non fundable University, research institute and other research institute.
Eligible topics	The call topics listed below are supported by organisation. Applying for funding for any other topic is not permitted. Topic 1: Genetic, epigenetic and environmental risk and protective factors for neurodegenerative diseases Topic 2: Longitudinal cohort approaches in neurodegenerative diseases Topic 3: Advanced experimental models of neurodegenerative diseases
Additional requirements	All applicants have to submit, mandatory, the pre-proposal to the Ministry of Health through IRCCS Scientific Directorate, by Research Workflow IT System, max 10 days before the pre-submission deadline, in order to confirm eligibility matter, in relation to their own institutional recognized scientific area.
