Pursuant to the Research and Innovation Promotion Act RIPA and the legal framework of the SNSF, no research grants are awarded if the relevant research is conducted for directly commercial purposes or if the persons involved in the research work are not scientifically independent.</p>
Additional requirements	<p>Participation as Swiss applicant to the JPND 2018 call is restricted to one proposal.</p> <p>Interested applicants must contact the SNSF administrative office (claudia.ellenrieder@snf.ch) to confirm eligibility prior to proposal submission.</p> <p>Swiss applicants must include a list of publications of the last 5 years (2013-2018) in the pre-proposal submission. This document must be sent separately to claudia.ellenrieder@snf.ch.</p> <p>Upon invitation to submit a full proposal, Swiss applicants must include a detailed SNSF budget form. This document must be sent separately to claudia.ellenrieder@snf.ch.</p> <p>Submission of the formal proposal at national level will be carried out once the international evaluation is finalized. The Swiss project partner(s) will then be invited by the SNSF to submit the proposal(s).</p>

	<p>Please note that in case of funding, applicants have to submit a Data Management Plan (DMP). Researchers need to develop a DMP for the entire Collaborative Research Project (CRP). The DMP must comply with the SNSF policy on open research data and is mandatory for the release of funds for Swiss sub-projects. They are calculated on the basis of the research funding acquired by eligible institutions under eligible funding schemes. Contributions are paid in retrospect at a flat rate.</p>
