## Eligibility for the 1001 Scientific and Technological Research Projects Funding Program

Eligible Institutions	The funding is granted to Principal Investigators from universities, public or private sector. The PI and researchers are subject to eligibility check.
Additional requirements	Participants from Turkey should also submit their proposals to TUBITAK electronically via ardeb-pbs.tubitak.gov.tr by 18th of March for pre-proposals (in Turkish) and 1st of July for the full proposal stage (in English). The signed hard copies should be sent to, TUBITAK UIDB Tunus Cad No:80 06100 Ankara within one month of the online submission.
	<ul> <li>Project Manager, Researchers and Advisors: <ul> <li>University personnel should have a PhD degree.</li> <li>Those working in a public institution or a private corporation should have an undergraduate degree.</li> <li>Except advisors, the project manager and researchers should reside and work in Turkey.</li> <li>A researcher should have a contribution of at least 10% of the project workload.</li> <li>An advisor is allowed if the project requires special expertise on a specific subject. The number of advisors in a project is limited to the number of specific subjects in the project.
