Eligibility

Eligible Institutions	Position in a university, research center or hospital. Research authority must approve position prior to submission. PI should hold a Ph.D., M.D., D.M.D., D. Sc or equivalent degree and employed by an eligible institution. Research will not be funded simultaneously by CSO-MOH on more than one grant (Era-NET or national). Researchers can not apply for more than one grant from any ERA-NET funded by CSO-MOH or submit more than one proposal to any programme.
Additional requirements	Prior to submission, researchers will submit to CSO-MOH an abstract approved by their research authority including budget distribution. No submission of abstract can result in declaration of the consortium as ineligible. If the application involves human or animal experiments, bioethics approvals must be submitted with the application or up to 4 months later. Financial and scientific reports required annually

Total earmarked national budget	Up to 300.000 euros as follows: Up to 140.000 per project and up to 20.000 per coordination
Anticipated no. of funded groups	Up to 2
Budget restrictions	Travel (up to 10%); No salaries for applicants; No heavy equipment,
Eligible costs	Materials and consumables; Travel (up to 10%); Institutional overhead 10%.
