Eligible Institutions	The Nominated Principal Applicant must have an academic or research appointment at an eligible institution (See Administration of CIHR Grants and Awards Funds for eligibility process and associated timelines).
Additional requirements	In addition to the application submission to the Joint Programme Neurodegenerative Disease Research (JPND), Canadian consortium members applying for funding from Canada must complete an abbreviated CIHR application (in either of Canada's official languages) and submit it using ResearchNet Only applications incorporating sex- and gender-based considerations in the proposed research will be eligible for funding from Brain Canada and Women's Brain Health Initiative (WBHI).
