Eligible Institutions	Universities, research centers or hospitals
Additional requirements	Prior to submission, researchers will submit to CSO-MOH an abstract approved by their research authority including budget distribution. No submission of abstract can result in declaration of the consortium as ineligible. If the application involves human or animal experiments, bioethics approvals must be submitted with the application or up to 4 months later. Submission of financial and scientific reports at the national level is required annualy. http://www.health.gov.il/research-fund

PI should hold a Ph.D., M.D., D.M.D., D. Sc or equivalent degree and employed by an eligible institution. Research will not be funded simultaneously by CSO-MOH on more than one grant (Era-NET or national). Researchers can not apply for more than one grant from any ERA-NET

funded by CSO-MOH or submit more than one proposal
for any programme.
