	<p>If one international project includes partners from at least two different Polish institutions, these institutions must apply as a group of entities. Each institution comprising this group has a separate budget, but the limit on the remuneration applies to the group as a whole.</p> <p>We strongly recommend Polish applicants to read information on eligible costs included in the Annex to NCN Council Resolution on funding granted within calls for proposals for international research projects (UNISONO).</p>
Eligible costs	<p>Applicants may apply for funding of costs relevant, necessary, and directly connected to the proposed research project, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Salaries and scholarships (including post-doc positions and scholarships/salaries for students and PhD students). <p>Please note: if the principal investigator is also the coordinator of an international consortium submitting a joint proposal the budget of salaries and scholarships may be increased.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Research equipment, devices and software: applicants may seek funding for research equipment up to PLN 500 000 per unit.• Other direct costs: materials and consumables, outsourcing and subcontracting, business trips, visits and consultations, collective investigators, other costs;• Overheads: indirect costs of open access of up to 2% of direct costs that may be spent on open access to publications and research data; other indirect costs of up to 20% of direct costs that may be spent on costs that are related indirectly to the research project, including the cost of open access to publications and research data.
